

## ORDINANCE 20220310

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUDSON, TEXAS, DECLARING THE THREE CANDIDATES FOR OFFICES OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN ARE UNOPPOSED; PROVIDING THAT THE MAY 07, 2022, REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION SHALL NOT BE HELD; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THE ORDINANCE WAS PASSED WAS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hudson, Texas, passed Ordinance No. 20220217 on February 17, 2022, ordering a regular municipal election to be held on May 07, 2022 for the purpose of electing three officials of the City, to wit: (2) year term of (1) Mayor and (2) Alderman; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 143.007 and 146.054, Texas Election Code, the deadline for filing applications for a place on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy for the City's regular municipal election have expired; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary, in accordance with Section 2.052, Texas Election Code, has certified in writing to the City Council that Robert Smith is unopposed for Mayor and Terry Taliaferro is unopposed for Alderman and Rachella Massey is unopposed for Alderman; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that the candidates whose names are to appear on the ballot in said election are unopposed, there are no declared write-in candidates, and no propositions to appear on the ballot for said election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUDSON, THAT:

1.

The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

2.

In accordance with Section 2.053(a), Texas Election Code, the following unopposed candidates are hereby declared duly elected to the respective offices shown and shall be issued a certificate of election.

Mayor - Robert Smith Alderman - Terry Taliaferro Alderman - Rachella Massey

3.

Pursuant to Section 2.053(b), Texas Election Code, the regular municipal election ordered by Ordinance No. 20220217, for May 07, 2022 shall not be held and is hereby canceled.

4.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be posted on Election Day; same being May 07,2022 at all polling places that would have been used in such election.

5.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

6.

The Code of the City of Hudson, Texas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

7.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any purpose by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

8.

It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public as required by Section 551.001 et seq., Texas Government Code, and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given.

9.

There exists a public emergency requiring that this Ordinance be passed finally upon the date of its introduction and first reading in order to timely prepare the ballot for early voting and to meet posting requirements and other provisions contained in the Texas Election Code.

10.

Robert Smith, Mayor

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its first and only reading.
