WHEN A PERMIT IS REQUIRED...

A permit is required when building, remodeling or enlarging a building. Permits are also required for other improvements to property.

Projects that are cosmetic, such as painting, wallpapering, carpeting, cabinets, and trim work do not require permits.

Additionally, permits are not required when replacing electrical fixtures with existing wiring, or existing plumbing fixtures.

Permits are required for the following project:

- Additions to a structure (residential or commercial)
- New residential building
 - Single family
 - Duplex
- Building remodel that requires the addition or removal of an interior or exterior wall, window, or door.
- Building or replacing a deck or porch
- Electrical work
 - Replacing meters
- Plumbing work
- Roof replacement
- In ground and above ground swimming pools
 - Storage pools are exempt and do not require a permit
- Hot tubs and spas
- Demolition of a building
- Signs
- New construction of a building (residential or commercial)
- Accessory building (storage building with foundations only)
 - Portable buildings are exempt and do not require a permit
- Carport (if concreted into the ground and is not portable)
